

## POKER TERMS

**Bet:** To make a wager by putting chips into the pot.

**Blind Bet:** A forced bet that must be posted before the player receives any cards.

**Call:** To post an amount equal to another player's bet.

**Check:** To abstain from betting, but continue to stay in contention for the pot because no other players have bet.

**Dealer Button:** A marker that moves clockwise around the table to give players equal positioning in the game.

**Fold:** To discard your cards and end your play for the hand.

**Muck:** to throw away your cards without exposing them.

**Raise:** To make a bet larger than the previous bet.

**Show:** To show one or both cards.

## TEXAS HOLD'EM ON POKERPRO®

1. Create your PokerPro® player card at the Customer Management System (CMS) station located in the PokerPro® area.
2. Deposit money into your account by visiting the PokerPro® CMS station located in the PokerPro® area.
3. Add your name to the waiting list by swiping card at the waiting list kiosk. Simply select the game you would like to play, and follow the on screen instructions.
4. Join the game by inserting your PokerPro® player card into the slot located at the top of your player screen. Insert the card with the magnetic stripe facing you and the arrows pointing down.
5. Enter the four-digit PIN you chose when you created your account and select the **OK** button.
6. Select the amount of money you wish to bring from your account to the game.
7. Play Poker!

## Poker Hand Ranks



**1: Royal Flush**  
A, K, Q, J, 10  
all of the same suit



**6: Straight**  
Five cards in sequence,  
but not in the same suit



**2: Straight Flush**  
Any five card sequence  
in the same suit



**7: Three of a Kind**  
Three cards of the  
same index



**3: Four of a Kind**  
All four cards of  
the same index



**8: Two Pair**  
Two separate pairs



**4: Full House**  
Three of a kind  
combined with a pair



**9: Pair**  
Two cards of the  
same index



**5: Flush**  
Any five cards of the same  
suit, but not in sequence



**10: High Card**

## ONCE YOU ARE IN THE GAME

### How to View Your Hole Cards

To view your hole cards, simply cup your hands around the cards and touch the screen above the cards.

### Community Cards and Table Stakes

The PokerPro® table clearly and quickly displays player commitments, table stakes, pot amount and community cards on the large display in the middle of the table. The table identifies the winner at the end of each hand, and winnings are immediately added to the player's table stakes.



### Bringing Money to the Table

Money you bring into a game is automatically withdrawn from your account and added to your table stakes. You can bring more money into the game at any time by selecting **Options** ->



## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Need a break or want to sit out?

1. Make sure your hand is folded.
2. Select **Options** in the upper right corner of your screen.
3. Select **Sit Out**.
4. When asked "Are you sure you want to sit out?" select **Yes**. If you are currently in a hand, you will be dealt out after the hand completes.

Do you want to quit?

1. Make sure your hand is folded.
2. Select **Options** in the upper right corner of your screen.
3. Select **Quit**.
4. When asked "Are you sure you want to quit?" select **Yes**. If you are currently in a hand, you will be dealt out after the hand completes.

Do you want to cash out?

When you leave the table, your table stakes are automatically deposited into your account. You can withdraw money from your account at any time by returning to the customer management system station. You may also leave money in your account to use at another time

Forgot what you had last hand?

Select **View Last Hand** in the upper right corner of your screen. You will see your last hand, the community cards and other cards that were shown, including the winner. If you folded your cards, touch the screen to see them.

Do you want to check your account balance?

1. Select **Options** in the upper right hand corner of the screen.
2. Select **Check Account Balance**.

What is the minimum amount of money needed to play?

You must put at least the amount equal to the minimum table stakes for the game you wish to play. This is determined by the operator.

Want to keep playing but need more money on your PokerPro® player account?

1. Simply revisit the PokerPro™ CMS. They will assist you with making a deposit. Once the cashier has completed your transaction, you can return to your seat.
2. Once logged back into the game (if you logged out), select **Options** in the upper right corner of your screen.
3. Select **Re-buy** and choose the amount you want to add to your table stakes. This number will vary depending on minimum buy-in.

Need to talk to a floor manager or host?

1. Select **Options** in the upper right corner of your screen.
2. Select **Call Host To Player**. This will notify a host that you have requested their assistance.



## HOW TO PLAY TEXAS HOLD'EM ON POKERPRO®

Object of the game

The object of the game is to **create the best five-card high hand** using a combination of the seven cards.

There are a **total of seven cards** (two hole cards and five community cards).

Before any cards are dealt

The player sitting directly to the left of the dealer button places a "**small blind**" bet. The player sitting directly left of the small blind position places a "**big blind**" bet. PokerPro® automatically posts the blind bets.

The Game

1. Players are **automatically dealt the first two cards** face down beginning with the player sitting in the small blind position.
2. This is followed by the first round of betting which has been started by the blind bets.
3. **The third, fourth and fifth cards are dealt face-up** in the center of the table. These cards are called the "**flop**."
4. For this round of betting and the remaining betting rounds, the option begins with the player sitting to the left of the dealer button.
5. **The sixth card is then dealt face-up** in the center of the table, followed by another round of betting round. This card is called the "**turn**" card.
6. Lastly, **the seventh card is dealt face-up** in the center of the table, followed by the final round of betting . This card is called the "**river**" card.
7. The cards of each player remaining in the hand will be turned face-up. The player with the highest five-card poker hand is automatically determined to be the winner and is immediately awarded the pot.
